

Rajagiri School of Engineering and Technology Placements – 2011

Placements at RSET belie predictions every time; whatever be the odds, RSET remains a preferred choice for the top recruiters in the country. And the placements for the 2011 pass-outs have once again testified to the worth of our graduates in the profession. With 300 Rajagirians placed across various companies in a timeframe of less than 2 months, we have crossed a ground breaking threshold in RSET's history at a time when we are celebrating 10 years of excellence in Engineering Education.

The placements for the 2011 batch started on December 13, 2010, with TCS being the first to visit the campus, and recruiting 146 students. On December 22, 2010, HCL visited the campus, recruiting 66. Just before the year drew to a close, Patni Computers arrived for recruitment, selecting 30 students.

The New Year continues to keep the spirits high on the RSET campus, with UST Global choosing 25 students on January 4, 2011, which was followed by Visual IQ, a leading marketing intelligence products firm offering jobs to 7 students on January 10, 2011. Arbitron visited the campus on 11th January 2011 and recruited 8 students. IBS recruited 10 students in the drive which was conducted on January 13, 2011. Nest visited the campus on January 21, 2011 and hired 13 students. Four students have been offered jobs by Accenture also. Syntel has recruited 6 students after test held at RSET campus on 9th January 2011 and interviews held later. Mphasis recruitment was held on 27th Jan 2011 and offered jobs to five students. The total number of students placed touched 300 with 58 students receiving double offers when Robert Bosch Engineering and Business Solutions Limited (RBEI), the technology flagship of Bosch in India visited our campus on 4th February 2011 and hired 38 students. SunTec Business Solutions visited the campus on 15th February 2011 and a student was recruited. 9 students have been placed with Sutherland and 12 students with CSS Corp, a global ICT Services company. Two students have been placed with Microsoft. 36 students were recruited by Wipro VLSI, which is the highest in the state for WiproVLSI. South Indian Bank also visited the campus in the month of April and recruited 7 students
