Item No.GB.04 (03) - Brief Report on activities at RSET after last meeting of GB

(a) NIRF RANKING

Rajagiri School of Engineering & Technology (Autonomous) has been ranked in the band of 200 to 250 as per the National Institutional Ranking Frame work (NIRF) of Ministry of Education -2022 ranking — Engineering college category.

(b) ACCREDITATION STATUS

National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has extended the accreditation of RSET (Autonomous) up to 31/12/2025 with a CGPA 3.03 and Grade "A".

National Board of Accreditation (NBA) has granted accreditation to B.Tech in CE, and extended the accreditation of the undergraduate programmes in AEI, CSE, ECE, EEE, IT and ME for a period of 3 years up to 30-06-2025.

(c) RESULT ANALYSIS 2018-2022 BATCH

On analyzing the result of 2018-2022 (KTU batch-Non Autonomous) the Governing Body members expressed concern on the lower pass percentage of EEE and AEI branches compared to other branches and directed to take effort to improve the pass percentage of both branches (AEI & EEE) (Result statistics annexed)



(d) PLACEMENT STATISTICS DURING 2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

The main highlights of RSET are its impressive placement record which shows excellent student quality, leadership and personality aspects. Around 147 companies visited our college during 2021-2022 academic year and 436 students have been placed out of 543 eligible students from a total strength of 695. Some of the Top recruiters include-INFOSYS, WIPRO, COGNIZANT, TCS, UST GLOBAL, IBM, ERNST & YOUNG, SOUTH INDIAN BANK and ACCENTURE.

(e) DEEKSHARAMBHAM-2022

Deeksharambham, the initiation ceremony of the 22nd batch of B.Tech and 14th batch of M.Tech students is to be held on 31st October 2022. Deeksharambham 2022 will be inaugurated by Sri. (f) ACADEMIC RETREAT

RIDHI 2022

RIDHI 2022 (Refine, Inspire, Develop for Huddle Improvement), the Academic Retreat for teaching and non teaching staff was conducted from 17th October to 26th October 2022.

Objective: OBE Outcome Based Education and to think, discuss and finalize collectively the plans for enhancing all aspects of education at RSET as per the requirements of the autonomous status particularly updating the syllabi and plan for three years before the next accreditation in 2025.

Dr. Umakanth P Kulkarni, SDM college of Engg, Dharward, Dr. Edamana Prasad & Dr. Vijayalakshmi V, IIT Madras, Dr. J David Ratnaraj, Controller of Examinations, Sri. Ramakrishna Engineering College (Autonomous) Coimbatore, Rev. Fr. Thomas Thekkel CMI, Provincial St Thomas CMI Province, Kozhikode were the resource persons for the program. The program was inaugurated by Director RSET, Rev. Dr. Jose Kuriedath and Concluding remarks were made by Rev. Dr. Jaison Paul Mulerickal, Vice Principal, RSET.

(g) STARTING OF NEW ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

The classes for the Final year students (VII Semester) have already begun and the third, second and first year (V, III and I Semesters) classes will s tart on 1st November 2022, Tuesday.

Item No.GB.04 (04) – Approval of minutes of the fourth Academic Council held on 18-10-2022

The minutes of the fourth academic council held on 18-10-2022 was presented by the Principal and was confirmed by the Governing Body. Certain discussions were held on the minutes as given below.

Dr. Prasad Krishna, Member, RSET, Governing Body and Director, NIT Calicut, and Surathkal emphasized the need for Internship for the B Tech students during vacation for a period of at least 2-3 months, as students of NIT and IIT currently have in India. He also said that there must be a departmentwise cell for internships categorized as academic internship, research internship and industry internship, under the guidance of a senior faculty member from the concerned department. This would help the students to find suitable jobs on completion of the course. He also said that longer duration of internship would attract good placement offers and immediate job opportunity. He also

suggested to have elective hours only in the final year and students in the final year may be permitted to take MOOC courses.

Rev. Fr.Jaison Mulerickal CMI, Member GoB RSET and Vice Principal also shared a thought of having separate office in the campus for Internship and Industry visit. Prof. P S. Sreejith, Principal RSET pointed out that mentors have been already appointed from amongst faculty members for assisting the students in identifying internship opportunities. Rev.Dr. Varghese Panthallookkaran CMI,Member GoB emphasized the need to provide continuous encouragement to students by the mentors (teachers) for taking on internships, innovative projects, industrial visits and entrepreneurship for their career growth.

<u>Item No.GB.04 (05) – Approval of appointment of staff members from last GB meeting to date</u>

Ten teaching and six non teaching staff members have joined since the last Governing Body meeting; whereas four teaching and 1 non teaching staff members have left the Institution during the same period.

Fourth Governing Body Meeting RSET (Autonomous) on 27th October -2022

ACTION ITEM

As per the discussions held during the third meeting of the GB on 24th June 2022, necessary changes have to be made in eligibility criteria for M Tech Degree admission to Computer Science & Engineering with specialization in Information Systems permitting those BTech graduate who have taken degree in Electronics/Electrical/Instrumentation (branches other than computer science) or computer science related branches.

Resolution of the Governing Body – The GB unanimously resolved to send a representation to Principal Secretary, Higher Education, Government of Kerala and Director, Department of Technical Education, Thiruvananthapuram for necessary changes in eligibility criteria for M Tech admission.

Action Taken Report: A formal letter has been sent to Principal Secretary, Higher education, Government of Kerala and Director, Department of Technical Education, Thiruvananthapuram. A copy the letter is attached herewith. No reply has been received so far in this regard and later it is understood that as per the fresh eligibility criteria published in the website of Technical Education, Government of Kerala Thiruvananthapuram, Those students who took B Tech degree in ECE/EEE / AEI EI etc are also eligible for admission to MTech degree in Computer Science & Engineering with specialization in Information Systems.
