

B.TECH. FIRST SEMESTER END SEMESTER EXAMINATION

B.Tech. First semester End Semester Examination will start from 9th April 2021 in offline mode as already announced.

Hall ticket will be available for students in their REXA Student Portal from 6th April onwards.

Students who have tested Covid positive on or after 26 March 2021 can write the End Semester Examination in May 2021 with supplementary examination. However, for students tested Covid positive on or after 26th March 2021, this examination will be considered as their first chance.

Students who have tested positive on or after 26 March 2021 should inform the class teacher before 7th April 2021. An email also should be sent to rset_support@rajagiritech.edu.in with the test report attached.

Hostelers can check in on 7th or 8th April with the test report of Rt PCR test taken on or after 5th April 2021.

Instructions to students appearing for the End Semester Examination:

- 1. Students should take the printout of the hall ticket and should bring their hall tickets and identity cards on all days of the examination failing which they will not be admitted to the examination hall.
- 2. Students should enter the examination hall at least 15 minutes before the commencement of examination and shall not leave the room during the last ten minutes.
- 3. Students are permitted to use only blue or black ink pens for writing examinations.
- 4. No materials except, writing materials and hall ticket are allowed in the examination hall. Mobile phones, Smart watches, Programmable Calculators, and other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited in the examination hall. Logarithmic tables, Calculators and other drawing equipment may be allowed only if they are required (and not provided by the college) for answering questions and the question paper contains a note to this effect, with the permission of the invigilator.
- 5. Instances of malpractice such as copying using manuscripts, copying from other candidates, smuggling of answer books, indecent behaviour in the examination room, use of unfair means etc. are liable to be punished as per rules.

- 6. Students should write Question paper code, Course code, Course name etc. in appropriate places in the answer books. Instructions given in the answer books and Question paper should be strictly followed.
- 7. They should not write anything in the Question paper other than their names and register number.
- 8. Strict silence should be maintained in the examination hall. Students are not allowed to get clarifications from other students. In case of any doubt, they can seek the help of the invigilator.
- 9. They should return all answer books before leaving the room. Students are not permitted to leave the examination hall without the permission of the Invigilator during the examination.
- 10. Students are not allowed to leave the hall before the expiry of one hour from the commencement of the examination.
- 11. No students shall be allowed to leave the examination hall till the expiry of one hour after a question paper has been given out and no student who leaves the room during the period allotted for the paper shall be allowed to return within that period.
- 12. Students who leave the examination hall more than half an hour earlier than the scheduled time for the close of the examination should surrender their question papers with their names and register numbers written on them to the Invigilator and the student may collect them back after the examination, if they so desire.
- 13. Students who leave the hall refusing to surrender the question papers, as stated above shall not be allowed to take examinations on subsequent days and the matter may be reported to the Controller of Examinations.
- 14. Students are permitted to leave the examination hall only after his/her answer book is taken charge of by the invigilator on duty in the hall. They should not be permitted to leave the hall after keeping their answer books in their seats.
